### PART I – GENERAL

#### 2.02 CDPHE SUPPLEMENTAL GENERAL CONDITIONS

- A. **ADD** Section V – Davis-Bacon Wage Requirements

- 1. **ADD** Paragraph 1. to read as follows:

"1. The Davis-Bacon prevailing wage requirements are made applicable to this project in accordance with the requirements of the project's funding assistance program. All wage rates shall be determined by the Heavy Construction Project General Decision No. CO100012, Modification No. 19, dated May 20, 2011 and the Building Construction Project General Decision No. CO100006, Modification No. 7, dated May 6, 2011. See the following wage decisions. "

- 2. **INSERT** after Paragraph 1. the attached eleven (11) pages consisting of the Heavy General Decision Number: CO100012 dated 05/20/2011 and the Building General Decision Number: CO100006 dated 05/06/2011

## 2.03 TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

### B. Section 01060 - Regulatory Requirements

1. **ADD** the following Paragraph 1.1.A.16.a) to read as follows:

"a) Additional information on obtaining this permit can be obtained via the Water Quality Permitting web page at <http://www.cdphe.state.co.us/wq/PermitsUnit/index.html>. This permit is required when construction activities disturb one acre or more of land."

### C. Section 02200 - Earthwork

1. **ADD** the following Paragraph 3.2.D.1.d) to read as follows:

"d) Additional information on obtaining this permit can be obtained via the Water Quality Permitting web page at <http://www.cdphe.state.co.us/wq/PermitsUnit/index.html>. A construction dewatering permit is required when a discharge to state waters is necessary during dewatering operations."

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#### WAGE DETERMINATION APPEALS PROCESS

1.) Has there been an initial decision in the matter? This can be:

- \* an existing published wage determination
- \* a survey underlying a wage determination
- \* a Wage and Hour Division letter setting forth a position on a wage determination matter
- \* a conformance (additional classification and rate) ruling

On survey related matters, initial contact, including requests for summaries of surveys, should be with the Wage and Hour Regional Office for the area in which the survey was conducted because those Regional Offices have responsibility for the Davis-Bacon survey program. If the response from this initial contact is not satisfactory, then the process described in 2.) and 3.) should be followed.
